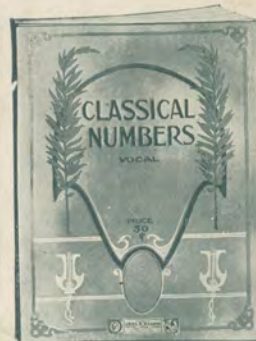


Classical Folio of Instrumental Selections
